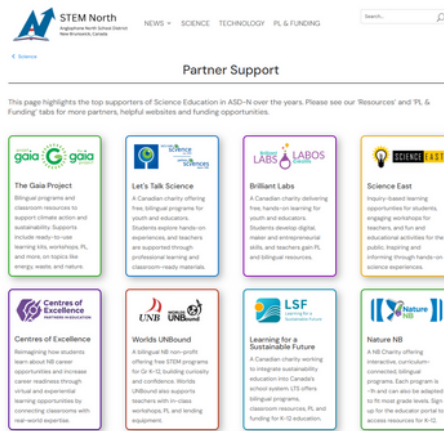
In Local News...
