Student Project Submission

Registration is now open and closes Mar. 16th. Students who participate in this district event will be judged, and Gr. 7-12

students are eligible to advance to the Canada-Wide Science Fair in Edmonton, AB, May 23-30. They may enter in either of the two categories: Discovery or Innovation. A tri-fold board is required. A report is required only if chosen for CWSF. Evidence of the process in the form of a science journal is recommended (especially for CWSF).

Maximum number of projects that can be registered from your school is 8 projects at each of the grade levels: 3-5, 6-8, 9-12.

Showcase Submission



Showcase submissions are open to K-12 students and classes to highlight some of the amazing Science and STEM learning happening in their school. These projects are not judged in the district event but students

attending will also have the opportunity to participate in STEM activities, and be eligible for door prizes during the day.

Maximum of 4 students per showcase. K-5 students will need to have an adult supervisor in attendance.
